New roads for Caracol



For many residents of the Caracol, the cobble stones paving our roads, are an aspect of the Caracol that add a certain charm to the hill. At the same time, they brutalize our cars, shaking the bolts from the undercarriage. The "Easy Rider" road enhancement project is a way to keep the charm of the cobbles, while reducing the cost and time for road maintenance. The interlocking pavers provide an attractive addition to the cobbles.

- Providing a uniform surface for walking and biking
- Dramatically reducing tire noise
- Allowing a silky smooth ride around the hill
- Saving us money by minimizing road maintenance

Careful management reduced the original cost from 133 USD/meter, to a more affordable 69 USD/meter, a real bargain for two lanes, each 1 meter wide. We are asking everyone to contribute 500 USD to the road construction,

but any amount you contribute is greatly appreciated. Currently 23,500 USD have been raised, exclusive of the Caracol member dues. The five year, five phase plan estimate is 110,000 USD to place pavers on the steep sections of the Caracol roads. Phase 2 is nearing completion, and Phase 3 is starting soon.
