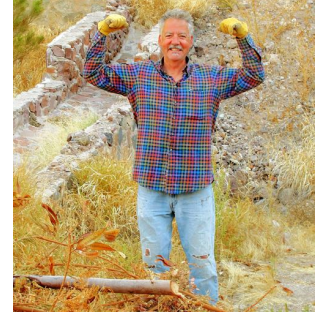

The beach, empty lots and road sides have been used as dumps for palm fronds and other types of organic waste. This material is unsightly. It encourages

infestation by animals, insects, and provides fuel for wildfires. The loss of the Departamento de bomberos in San Carlos makes fire prevention critical on the hill.

During the cleanup, over 4000 lbs of refuse was dragged to collection sights. This resulted in 5 dump truck loads of litter removed from the hill.
