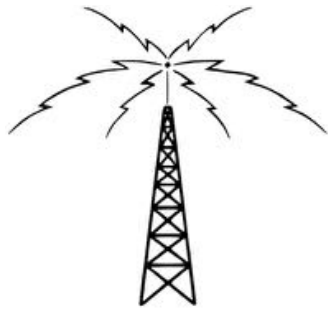

The Caracol association decided that rather than replace the wire at considerable expense, we would install a radio linked switch that now signals the lower pump to activate.
