Roger Stevens has been working hard, moving the gate project forward. The bypass road is still in use, so those coming down soon, pay attention to the signs to detour around the new gate. The gate construction has taken much longer than everyone had hoped. But, the good news is that the end is in sight. The final grading is underway, and the final roadway surface will be laid soon. We hope that that the major construction will be

finished in the first half of November. We can then begin the installation of electronics and gate hardware. On a brighter note, there have been several street lights that had failed. This seems to be a ongoing problem, and the Association has spent a lot of money and time getting the lights repaired in the past. San Carlos Comisario, Efrain Soto was able to connect the new supervisor (Julio Bueno) in charge of the Obras Publicas (Public Works Dept) in Guaymas with Nidza and Jim Busse, who have been overseeing the street light repairs. Guaymas sent a night crew (how relevant) to the Caracol, and with parts supplied by the Association, they were able to repair 18 street lights. There are still a few lights to repair, but some need to wait for the finish of the new entrance gate.
