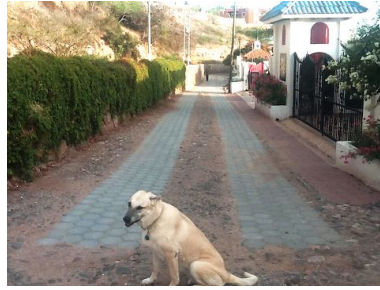

### Pop, sparkle and buzz electric ...



On July 23, around 4 am a major lightning strike knocked out the power on the Caracol for 10 hrs. The control system to keep the upper pila filled was destroyed. The control system has a component located in the lower pila that was also damaged. New components are in route to San Carlos, and repairs will begin soon. The water company will manually fill the upper pila until repairs are finished.

The entry wall is built and primed! Painting and metal lettering will be completed and installed this week. The

signage will say "Caracol Peninsula". The Irrigation and planting in front and to the sides will be done in the Fall/Winter. The wall was built with recycled block from the adoquin pallets. Two tons of trash and landscape waste, that had been thrown over many years, was cleared to prepare the area for the wall. Nine volunteers helped with this project. Primer and paint left from the Pila project was used to prep the wall. Lettering is being made by local welder, Rogelio, for \$240 USD, as opposed to a source in the United States for \$1,000USD.

In June we discussed the work under way on Paseo Camaron from lot 596 to lot 587 . The installation of the Adoquin is now finished and really makes the ride/walk much smoother. This improvement to the Caracol roads was paid by the residents living along this section of road.
