As is typical of this time of year, things are quite on the hill. Things have been running smoothly. Residents will start drifting back to San Carlos from the northern realms over the next few weeks. As the residents return they will be greeted by a new addition at the front entrance!

A project organized by the Beautification Committee is getting closer to completion. The crew headed by Juan Caballero built our new wall

from the recycled block used in the roads project, with paint and primer left over from the Pila project. We had an estimate for over \$1,000 USD for lettering from the States (without installation). To our great fortune, we were able to hire Rogelio Uribe from Rogelio's Welding to construct the letters, paint and install them for around \$230 USD. The letters are 1/16 inch steel, painted with a rust proof paint, and installed slightly out from the wall. This allows us to take them down when repainting is necessary. We are not quite finished yet. During November and December, we will lay irrigation and do the landscaping around the entrance.
