CARACOL SEMANTA SANTA 2018

Semanta Santa in San Carlos is almost upon us. It last from Palm Sunday to Easter (March 25 – April 1, 2018). It is Mexico's second most important holiday season, after Christmas. Many Mexicans take the holiday as a vacation to play in the water, camp on the beach, gather with family and drink, eat and party. Many visitor also take the opportunity to tour the Caracol and utilize our area and rental properties that become the centers for parties.

Because of the many visitors we need to carefully control who has access to the hill and how long they stay to keep the Caracol **CLEAN, SAFE, PEACEFUL AND SECURE.**

The Caracol will be hiring additional guards for the period of March 26 - April 4th. During the day, one of the guards will be stationed at the top of the beach access road from 10 AM until the beach is closed at 7 PM. The recreation area (beach) will be limited to a certain number of families to keep it a **SAFE, CLEAN, SECURE and an Enjoyable environment for families.** Vehicles will be limited on the access road, allowing emergency vehicles passage for both the visitors and residents protection. The Association will pay for the beach toilet and have it cleaned each day for the publics benefit to keep the recreation area Clean and Safe.



Two guards will be stationed 24 hrs/day at the Caracol entrance. This will provide enhanced coverage during the busy part of the day and evening. Passes for residents, visitors and maintenance personal should be displayed in their vehicles.

After 11 PM (the beginning of quite time on the hill) residents are encouraged to call the guard house phone number (**226-1040**) to report loud parties that interrupt the peace and

safety of the neighborhood. The guards will call the police. The goal is to keep the Caracol: **CLEAN, SAFE, PEACEFUL AND SECURE**
