### The magic in this planet is contained in water!

The work on the replacement lower pila is now finished. No more raccoons doing the back stroke in the Caracol water supply! Thanks to the CEA for their cooperation in the replacement, Victor Toledo, Josh Douglas and crew, all who worked hard to replace the lower pila quickly. Also, thanks to all the volunteers who were diligent in keeping the temporary bypass running so that the hill could have water during the transition. The design of the new lower pila increases the height of the tank by approximately 4 feet and allows the water to be drawn down very near the bottom of the pila. This increases our storage capacity by approximately 4 times or enough to fill the upper pila 2 and one half times. This should decrease the number of times we are out of water when input from the CEA stops.



The photo on the left is one of three of our regular entrance guards, Gonzalo. Gonzalo has been watching our gate for several years now, and does an excellent job. Always friendly, but keeps a close eye on visitors. It increases security on the hill if Gonzalo and the other guards know the residents. Please say Hi as you come through the gate, and drop off a cold drink on a hot day.

The association is going to be paying for an additional guard at the entrance gate on Sundays, from May through September, 2018. Having two guards helps discourage the more aggressive sightseers that try to access the hill, as well as control the number of cars accessing the Caracol Beach. As always our motivation is to keep the hill *Safe, Peaceful and Secure*.

Many residents who normally help out on the hill are gone for higher ground until the fall.
