The goal is simple: safety and security.




There is much attention this month on the beach road. There are several issues with the beach access. The road has always been rough, difficult to walk on and expensive to maintain. Most visitors to the beach drive their cars to the bottom of the road blocking access to residents homes and making emergency services access very difficult. We have tried having a guard near the top to stop cars during the busy weekends with limited success. Laying Adoquin pavers has begun near the top to improve the drive and walking experience on the steep road. Eventually there will be two Adoquin lanes to the bottom of the hill. The hope was to install a gate

system at the top, similar to what is at the entrance of the Caracol to control automobile access to the beach area with a guard to raise and lower the gate. Visitors will have to walk to the beach and leave their cars on the upper road.

After the Adoquin installers finish the top portion of the beach road, they are going lay the pavers that will extend the road below the entrance gate all the way to the Six store. Should make a nice smooth ride for the bike riders up/down the hill. The installation of the Adoquin at the bottom of the road is made possible by very generous donations by Caracol Residents.

Ken and Deb Geisler hosted a Pot Luck on April 6th at their home. The party was a great time for everyone with about 50 residents bringing plenty of food and drinks to be shared with all. Plaques in appreciation for their work supporting the Caracol were given to Andy Winstrom, Deb Geisler, Art Lewis.

Many Caracol residents have donated to “adopt the median” from the Six store to the Captains Club. The project consist of cleanup, rock work, curb painting, weed removal and planting over fifty bougainvilleas. A two year maintenace plan was funded to care for the median plantings. Two signs declaring the Caracol’s efforts will be placed in the median.
